Daniel 2:28a

- Theme: A spiritual attack isn't a sign you're doing something wrong; it's often because you're doing something RIGHT.
- Daniel's work history under 4 kings 605-530 BC
 - ✓ King Nebuchadnezzar - Babylonian conqueror
 - ✓ King Belshazzar - Nebu's grandson - WALL WRITING
 - ✓ King Darius - Administrative genius - MEDE
 - ✓ King Cyrus - PERSIAN sent Jewish exiles home
 - ✓ One word DISTINGUISHED, Hebrew Mitnassah - Daniel 6:1-3,
- Colossians 3:17
- Three qualities of unshakable impact
 - 1) Serve God with INTEGRITY - Daniel 6:4-5
 - Daniel lived in Babylon, but Babylon WASN'T IN HIM
 - Options: STOP praying, pray silently or KEEP praying
 - 2) Trust God with CONSISTENCY - Daniel 6:10
 - It's not what we do OCCASIONALLY that makes the difference, it's what we do consistently
 - "There is a God in Heaven" - Daniel 2:21 NLT
 - 3) We honor God with FAITHFULNESS
 - Daniel trusted God EITHER WAY - Daniel 6:16, 18, 23
 - When we do what is right, we can always trust God with the RESULTS

Conclusion - Daniel was a picture of JESUS: Conspiracy, traps, falsely accused, condemned to die, put in a cave/sealed and walked out alive.
